By way of introduction, my greatest sense of gratitude goes to you, on behalf of our Board, Management Team, Staff and Beneficiaries, for the Covid-19 Emergency Food Relief Funds which we have received from you with the primary aim of cushioning us from the effects of Covid-19 Pandemic. With our 1st School Term abruptly and prematurely ended on March the 18th (instead of on the 20th) and by consequence, the closure of the Centre due to the National Lockdown Restrictions whose aim was to contain the spread of the Virus, it meant a loss to our children for a daily nutritious meal both from the School and the Centre levels, respectively. With most of their caregivers (parents and guardians) laid off from their employment and losing on their Monthly Family Income, this intervention could not have come at an appropriate time. Also encouraging (though still remaining difficult and frightening) is the fact that Schools have, since the 1st of this month, reopened only for their Grades 7's and 12's Learners, thus making it possible for them to resume their School Feeding Schemes.

In terms of our response to the deposit receipt of your Funds into our Bank Account, we hastened to place an Order of Grocery and Washing Powder Soap Items (including Hand Sanitizers and Hygiene Hand Wash Soaps to be used by the children when the Centre reopens) at Moloto SuperSpar on Tuesday the 9th, whose delivery (through a Truck and Van making four/4 Loads-drives) then was effected on Thursday for the Friday the 12th distribution to the beneficiaries. Besides compiling this Narrative Report, I am also requested to pass on to you and an entire Masibambisane Board, deepest sense of appreciation for the Relief received, thus practically demonstrating the Love of Our Lord and Saviour, Christ Jesus!!!
